GRACE

Have you ever wondered, "What actually is God's grace?" Grace is defined as the free and unmerited favor of God as manifested in the salvation of sinners. In a Christian sense, God's grace is unmerited mercy (favor/gift) that God gave to humanity by sending His perfect Son to die on a cross, thus delivering eternal salvation to all who are called to faith (whewww that's a mouthful!)

God's grace so vital that Luther would name it as one of the five 'solas' or pillars of the reformation. Can you name all five? (Christ alone, Faith alone, Grace alone, Scripture alone, God's glory alone) Why is God's grace so important? What does God's grace do?

Paul writes to the Ephesians in chapter 2, verses 8-9, "For it is <u>by</u> <u>grace</u> you have been <u>saved</u>, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the <u>gift of God</u>—not by works, so that no one can boast."

God's grace is that which makes the impossible, possible through the blood of God's Son, Jesus the Christ. God's grace allows forgiveness to the unforgiveable. God's grace gives new life to the dead. God's grace gives hope... for the whole world, including us!

In fact, that's the whole story of the Bible. An epic story about the wild, outlandish, extravagant grace of God – it's without limits or borders or quotas. It stretches to the ends of the earth and beyond! And it's for you...


As you review your Stewardship materials, please take the time to look over the many committees and groups that could use your help. Also, review your financial situation and determine what commitment you can make for next year.

PARISH NURSE NEWS-OCTOBER 2021

I'm still collecting medications for the Bunnell/Flagler Free Clinic- the box is in the conference room marked medications. Please no narcotics as they will not accept them.

THE GOOD AND THE BAD ABOUT FATS:

Fats help our digestive system absorb certain vitamins from the foods we eat, however, there are still some fats we should all avoid. Saturated fats should be avoided or decreased in everyone's diet as it increases the level of LDL cholesterol (the bad cholesterol). This develops into an increased risk in heart disease. Good news is that unsaturated fats reduce the risk of heart disease according to scientific studies. Unsaturated fats are found in cooking oils at room temperature, nuts, seeds, avocado, and fatty fishes such as salmon, sardines, and herring. Saturated fats are found in butter, lard, full fat milk, cheeses and yogurt, and high fat meats. So, what should we try to eat? Try limiting fatty red meats with lean meats, fish, and poultry. Include plant oils like canola, sunflower, safflower, soybean, corn, and nut oils. Replace processed grains such as white bread and white rice with whole grains and brown rice. Eat plant based foods that contain healthy fats. Eat healthy!!!

Noah's Ark Preschool October 2021- Newsletter

The first month of school is complete and we have all survived! The inspections have been detailed and flawless. We just received our license renewal for another year from DCF, the Early Learning Coalition has fully approved our VPK students, and our enrollment has increased by 4 more children. We have reached our limit based on the number of teachers we have, so we currently have a waiting list of 3 children, and we are looking for one teacher.

Our VPK students have all taken the first State of Florida test, and they have a lot of room to grow and learn between now and May of 2022. The assessment covers four areas; print knowledge, phonological awareness, oral language/ vocabulary, and mathematics. The questions usually mean picking out the appropriate picture in a grid of 4 pictures, however, near the end of the test, they have to answer logical questions, i.e. "Who is faster, a turtle or a tiger?" They are also doing daily seatwork, and learning their "sight" words to prepare them for reading, as well as tracing their name, and learning their "letters" and "numbers". Last year's VPK class is doing very well in Kindergarten, and thinks the work is easy, so what we are doing on a daily basis is working well for Kindergarten preparation.

We try to remember every moment is a teaching moment, and the little ones are sponges soaking up the learning. October is Halloween and the Pumpkin Patch and a big Halloween party. Stay tuned.
