A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR Holy week is the last week of Jesus' life on earth (well, kind of). Sometimes called the Passion of Christ, this week follows the events of the last few days of Jesus' life, His death and burial, and ultimately (spoiler alert) His resurrection!

We remember and mark this holy time through, you guessed it, worship! All of the worship services run together as one continuous event – telling the world-changing story that occurred some 2000 years ago near Jerusalem.

Palm Sunday - Jesus enters Jerusalem, as a very different kind of king, with a very different kind of kingdom. Shouts of 'Hosanna' fill the air and palm branches fill the streets as Jesus humbly enters town on a colt.

Maundy Thursday - Maundy means command. Jesus shares a last meal with His followers, instituting what we know as the Lord's Supper or Holy Communion. At the meal, Jesus breaks bread and says "This is My Body" and shares a common cup, saying "This is My Blood". Jesus also gives a new command (look it up in John 13:34-35).

Good Friday – we enter the barren worship space as we hear about the crucifixion of Jesus. Christ is crucified, for us and the whole world.

Easter Sunday – we return to the worship space (Friday's tomb), to see and hear the Good News! JESUS HAS RISEN! Shouts of ALLELUIA fill the sanctuary, our lives, and we pray, the whole world!

PARISH NURSE NEWS-APRIL 2022

The Bunnell Free Clinic wanted me to say "THANK YOU" for your donations of medications!!

DO I HAVE A DRUG ALLERGY:

Medications are used more and more as weapons against germs and various diseases. But, sometimes, we can develop allergies to those medications that are helping us because our body's immune system is overreacting to them. Antibiotics, especially Penicillin, and pain medications are commonly known for many reactions. However, any drug can cause an allergic reaction.

Watch for skin rashes, hives, itching, swelling, wheezing, lightheadedness, or difficulty breathing. Anaphylaxis is the most severe seen and usually occurs within a few seconds or minutes of exposure to allergic substances. However, with medications you may not see any symptoms immediately. Seek immediate medical help if you develop swelling of the lips, difficult breathing, choking, lower blood pressure or fainting.

In some cases, people have experienced nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and headaches after taking medications. These symptoms are usually not an allergic reaction, but are possibly an intolerance or sensitivity to a medication. I developed an intolerance to a common antiemetic drug which resulted in a dystonic reaction (an intermittent spasmodic or sustained involuntary contractions of the muscles in the face, neck, trunk, pelvis, extremities, and larynx). Seek immediate medical attention if you experience any of the symptoms of dystonia.

The good news is that other medications may be used if you develop an allergy to medications. Allergy testing may be done to determine if you are allergic to some medications. And, some drug allergies may fade over time. Don't forget to tell your health care providers about any allergies you have.
