# Pentecost 2022 - The Spirit is Moving

Thank you members and friends who worshiped in-person or virtually with Grace Lutheran on June 5th and responded so positively to our visit with Pr. Slavik from Word of Life Church in Palm Coast. We were able to provide over \$2,000 to the ministries of Word of Life Church; which include supplying basic needs (water and

food) to people still living in Ukraine and to refugees who have left the war-torn country. As the Holy Spirit was poured out on the early followers of Jesus (Acts 2), the Spirit continues to move, inspire and equip followers of Jesus today! Praise God!



#### A "Thank You" from Pr. Slavik

I wanted to thank you again for inviting me to the church and giving me an opportunity to share a little bit about my life, ministry. We are sending the relief funds to the pastors in different parts of Ukraine. Here is what is happening:

- 1. Evacuate people from dangerous zones more than 2300 people have been evacuated.
- 2. Feed the people more than 6500 lunches have been given out. 3. Gave around 1000 food packages to the needy. 4. Gave out more than 25000 liters of water. 5. Gave out about 5000 loaves of bread. 6. Give out clothing and mattresses. 7. Around 40 non-Christian people started coming to church. Four new people will be baptized soon. Every time we feed or provide relief to the people, we share the Gospel with them. This is just from one pastor in Ukraine, and there are many more who do the same kind of work in Ukraine now. Thank you so much for the financial blessing to the Ukrainian people. All the money goes to the Ukraine relief fund. Thank you so much!

## Florida-Bahamas 35<sup>th</sup> Synod Assembly Recap (June 3-5th)

#### **Bishop Suarez opening comments**

The theme of the conference will be: **Joyful – Patient - Faithful Romans 12:9-12** 

"Let love be genuine; hate what is evil, hold fast to what is good; love one another with mutual affection; out do one another in showing honor. Do not lag in zeal, be ardent in spirit, serve the lord. **Rejoice in hope, be patient in suffering, persevere in prayer**."

# <u>Keynote Speaker: Dr. Luis R. Torres-Hostos:</u> (1) Patient in Affliction, (2) Faithful in Prayer, and (3) Joyful in Hope

#### 1. Patient in Affliction

Our brains are wired for self-preservation....To discriminate at it's most basic, means, to recognize a distinction, to differentiate.

When humans began living in groups....Thousands of years ago they learned to be suspicious of others: outsiders of other groups of humans, people who didn't look like them etc. That was a survival mechanism. We still use it today without thinking.

The more different the "other" is.... The more our brains discriminate. But we must remain vigilant that our innate tendency to mistrust what is different doesn't lead to the other definition of discrimination. To make an unjust or prejudicial distinction in the treatment of different categories of people, especially on the grounds of race, sex, age, or disability.

Take a leap of faith and CHOOSE to see God in the "other", no matter how different from us.

#### 2. Faithful in Prayer

#### Being faithful in prayer requires.....

Intentionally: Setting aside a defined time and place to pray.

Humility: We must acknowledge that we are not the Good Samaritan, but we are the beaten man on the side of the road. We must strive to forgive ourselves before we ask for God's forgiveness.

Patience: If it was easy, everyone would do it all the time.

### 3. Joyful in Hope

No matter how much is going on around us - remember, we keep looking forward. We are never without hope. We know that "this too shall pass" and that brighter days are up ahead because our God is good, and his love for us is everlasting and unfailing.

"But those who hope in the lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary; they will walk and not be faint. (Isaiah 40:3)

If God calls us to be joyful in hope, who are we to say no?
