




Celebrating Our 64th Year

Recipe for Mini Cheesecakes Submitted by Ellie Faust Ingredients:

For the Crust:

18 Graham Crackers

4 tbsp. unsalted butter

1/4 cup sugar

2 tbsp. brown sugar

3/4 tsp of cinnamon

For the Cheesecake Filling:

1 lb cream cheese softened

1/4 tsp salt

1 tsp vanilla extract

2 large eggs (room temp) 2 egg yolks

1 cup sugar

1/3 cup sour cream

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees
- Add graham crackers to food processor or chopper and pulse until in small pieces. Add sugars and cinnamon and pulse. Melt butter and add to mixture.
- Line cupcake pan with liners. Press graham cracker mixture in to the cupcake liners, use back of spoon to flatten. Bake at 350 for 8 minutes. Remove from oven and set aside
- Add room temp cream cheese to mixer bowl. Beat cream cheese with sugar and salt. Add sour cream, extracts and mix well. Add eggs and yolks one at a time.
- Using ice cream scoop transfer the cheese cake mixture to the cupcake tin. Fill abt 3/4 of the way.
- Bake for 20 minutes. Turn off oven but leave door closed to allow the cake to set for an additional 25 minutes.
- Remove from oven and to cool for a few hours.
- Top with berries, chocolate or pie filling and whip cream and refrigerate.


